CLOTHES LIST FOR SIXTH FORM DAY STUDENTS

It is our expectation that every student is neatly turned out in clean, full School uniform.

Article	Notes
<i>2 Suits</i>	These are available from Horncastles but equivalent solid colour black or charcoal grey suits are acceptable. Skirts should be tailored and hems must be nearer to the knee than the hip. Trousers must be full length. The suit jacket or overcoat (see below) must always be the top layer, except in the Summer term when it is warm and students may remove their jackets.
<i>Pullover</i>	Solid colour black or grey v-necked long sleeved or sleeveless. No zips or logos. A pullover may be worn under, but not instead of, a suit jacket.
<i>Shirts</i>	Normal white poly-cotton type. No polo shirts. May be long or short sleeved. Should be suitable for wearing with a tie. Should not hang below the bottom of the suit jacket: must be tucked in, unless properly tailored, with all buttons done up. No bare midriffs.
<i>Sixth Form Tie*</i>	
<i>Tights or socks</i>	Plain black socks or tights. Laddered tights are not acceptable.
<i>Pair School Shoes</i>	Must be in good repair. They must be all black, and leather or leather-look. Trainers which match this criteria are fine. Ankle boots or long boots may not be worn. Shoes must not be of an extravagant style, i.e. no platforms or stiletto heels and a maximum of 2 inch heels.
<i>Mackintosh or Overcoat</i>	All students must possess a plain coat suitable for cold and/or wet weather. It may be dark navy blue, dark grey or black.
<i>Bag or Case</i>	These should be smart and in good repair. Bags with straps over both shoulders are preferable, although briefcases and large sport-style holdall bags are acceptable. Plastic carrier bags and Army surplus bags are not allowed. Suitable bags are available from Horncastles.

<i>Winter Hat</i>	School hat* or plain navy, black or grey.
<i>Scarf</i>	School scarf* or plain navy, black or grey.
<i>Pair Gloves</i>	Navy, black or grey.

Musicians: Students performing in concerts will wear all black, including an ankle length skirt or trousers.

A discount of 5% will be given on the purchase of all school wear at Horncastles during July. If parents use other reputable outfitters, they should check the regulations carefully as to the colour and style stipulated in the clothes list regulations.

Hair: Hair must be kept clean, neat and tidy. Long hair must be tied back whilst near the food serveries, during games or in Science labs, for hygiene and safety reasons. All hair bands and ties should be dark and discreet. Hair should not be visibly dyed or bleached; dramatic hair cuts and use of colourants are not acceptable. Headgear may not be worn, unless for religious observance or with the permission of the Divisional Head.

Jewellery: Students may wear one ring, one discreet silver or gold chain and one pair of simple stud or sleeper earrings in their ear lobes. Natural looking make up and clear or pale-coloured nail varnish are acceptable.

All belongings must be in good repair and clearly and indelibly named. All clothes must be marked (with name tapes and laundry pen). All other items, including personal effects, must also be clearly and indelibly marked. Valuables must be labelled, using a UV pen, with the student code. (The School uses a UV light to enable the return of valuable lost property to its owner.)

It is recommended that all motor cyclists and cyclists wear a Sam Browne Luminous Harness.
